Has the thought of getting an STI ever freaked you out? Having sexual **INTERCOURSE** is a big responsibility and practicing **SAFER SEX** is really important. Not using **PROTECTION** could put you at **RISK** for getting an STI. People don't just walk around with signs on their faces saying STI over here! This makes it difficult because you can't tell that someone has a STI just by looking at them; most times when someone has a STI they won't experience any **SYMPTOMS**. And even if someone does have symptoms like sores, genital warts, burning while urinating, itchiness in the genital area, or unusual **DISCHARGE**, other people might not know it.

When someone does know they have an STI they don't run in the streets and shout it out. Finding out you have been **DIAGNOSED** with an STI can be really hard and telling your partner is even harder. Sometimes people don't tell their partners or other people because they are afraid and that is totally normal. No one wants to be judged or get accused of cheating. But now-a-days the horror stories that are out there about STIs can make it difficult. But don't get freaked out. Get tested and take your partner along. **TESTING** and using **CONDOMS** are key to staying protected and **HEALTHY**.
